Planning Policy Agenda for the Integrated Management of Territorial Plan and Environmental Plan

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The Joint Order (2018) of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport and the Ministry of Environment was enacted for the integrated management of the National Land Plan and the Environmental Conservation Plan, which were declared in 2016 and 2015 in the Framework Act on the Basic Land and Environmental Policy, respectively. Thus, integrated management of the national land plan and the environmental conservation plan is necessary without conflicting land use and environmental conservation. At the same time, it is also necessary to find a detailed plan for promoting national land policy for integrated management, such as the introduction of the total natural resource system.

To cope with this institutional changes, through preemptive and proactive responses to domestic and foreign policy conditions, it is necessary to draw up issues for the integrated management of the national land plan and the environmental conservation plan, to prepare concrete practical measures,

and to seek ways to improve the legal system.

The main goals of this research are twofold. Firstly, it draws out detailed tasks of national land policy and suggests strategies to maintain the land environment in a sustainable manner through the land use and conservation that harmonizes development and the environment. Secondly, it tries to make the contribution to eco-friendly land use and the creation of a sustainable land environment by presenting detailed implementation plans for integrated management of national land plans and environmental conservation plans.
